Subject: 2026 Shared Use Path (SUP) Survey Results

Background: The Shared Use Path Master Plan was developed in 2009 by the City of Sanibel to provide both residents and visitors a recreational and leisure way of transportation throughout the island. At the beginning and throughout its enhancements, the safety of shared use path users is one of the highest priorities in the City's Master Plan. In 2006 and 2012, surveys were conducted to assess traffic at notable intersections along the shared use path. Since then, three recent surveys have been conducted in 2024, 2025 and 2026 to evaluate usage trends and track the continued emergence of E-bikes on the SUP.

The City of Sanibel was designated a Bicycle Friendly Community (BFC) and awarded gold status by *The League of American Bicyclists* in 2010. Gold award status is currently valid through 2027, with the renewal application due by June 17, 2026. Judges evaluate each application based on the desire of the municipality to improve biking for the unique needs of the people who live and visit the community. Higher award levels will be presented to renewing applicants who have consistently monitored the bicycle usage of the community. Retaining this prestigious gold designation is valuable for The City of Sanibel as it attracts both residents and tourists from around the globe. All Bicycle Friendly America (BFA) awardees are promoted on the League's interactive online [Bicycle Friendly America Awards map](#) and on their [Connect Locally map](#).

Previous Studies:

The first three surveys (2006, 2012, 2024) were conducted in late April on a Thursday afternoon from 12:30 until 4:30 p.m. and the following Saturday morning from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. The past two surveys (2025, 2026) were conducted in early April using the same timeframes to better capture what Sanibel looks like at the height of season. E-bikes were not prevalent in the first two studies, so there is no historical data on E-bike usage on the shared use path for 2006 and 2012. In 2024, 2025 and 2026, counts were collected on E-bikes as part of the survey.

New Study Results:

In the past two studies, 2025 and 2026, the surveys were conducted in mid-March with this year's beginning on Thursday, March 12th from 12:30 until 4:30 p.m. and concluding Saturday, March 14th from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. A reasonable margin of error must be considered, as volunteers were responsible for observing and recording usage with the human eye and hand-written tally sheets. It should also be noted that these studies were conducted less than four years after hurricane Ian struck Sanibel Island, and about two years after hurricane Helene and Milton did considerable damage as well.

Below are the results of the new 2026 study, complete with usage change from the three prior studies for comparable data. For viewing ease, the current 2026 results have been highlighted in light blue.

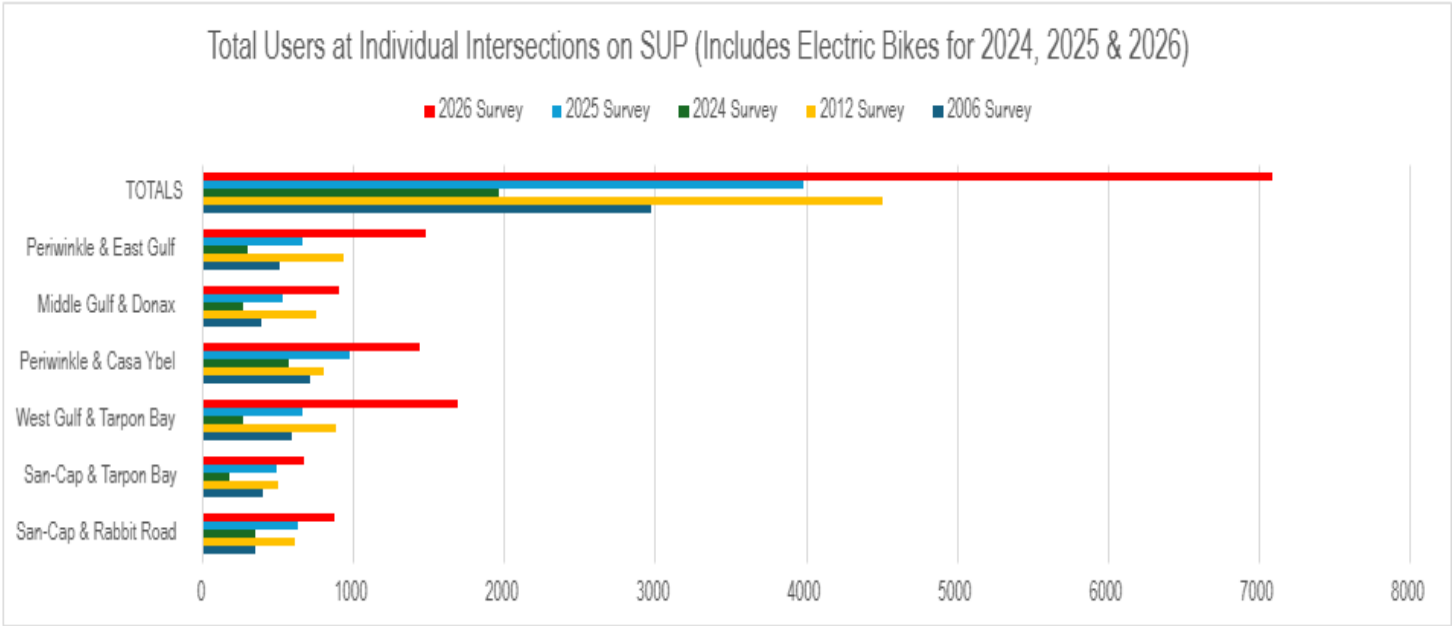

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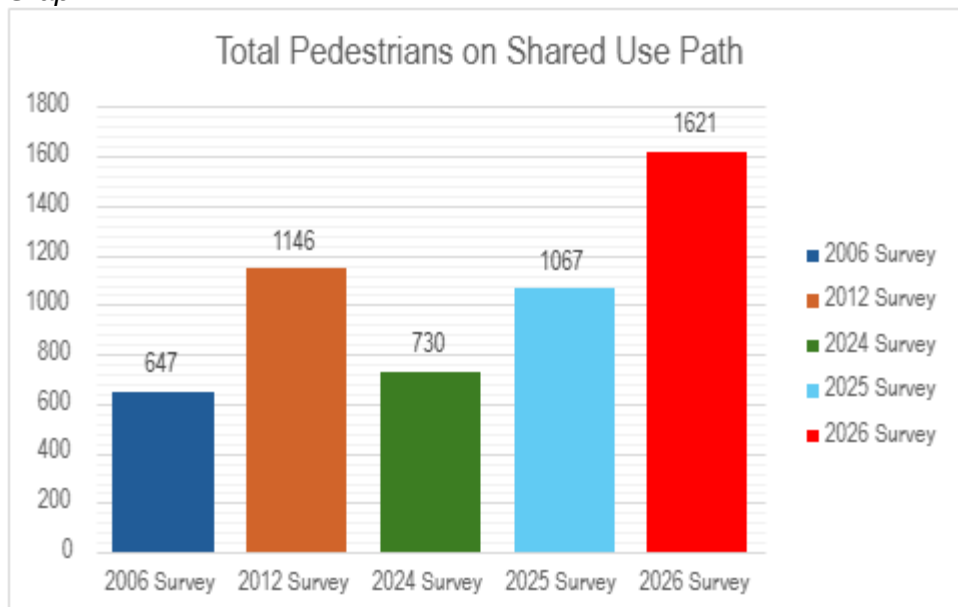

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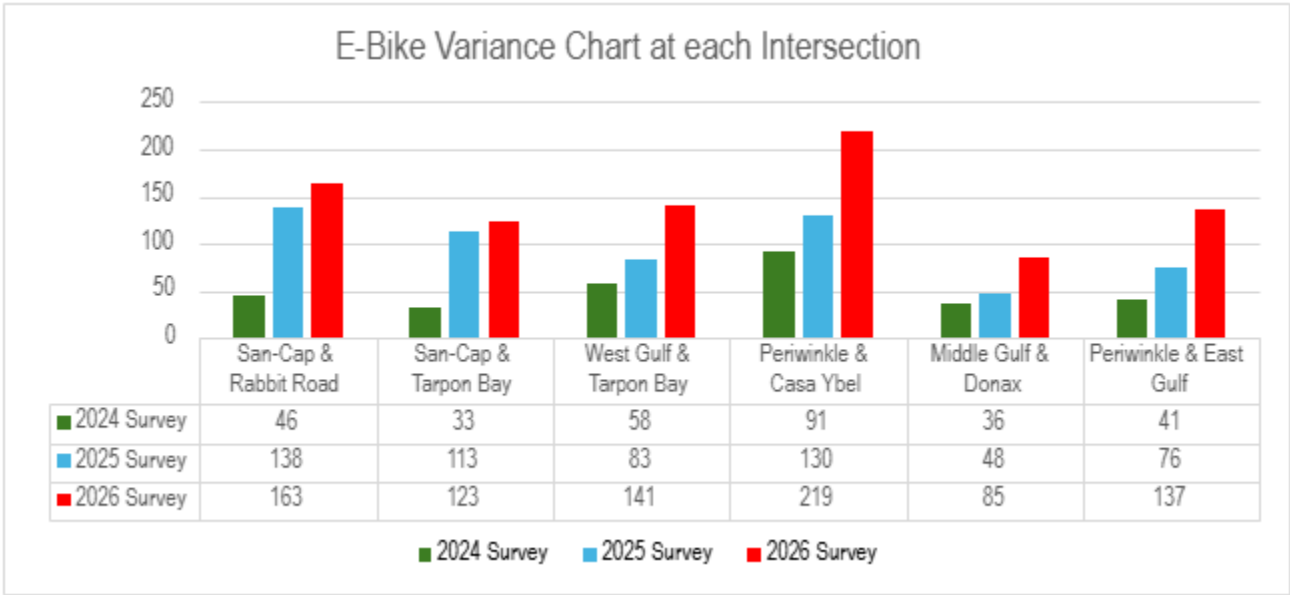

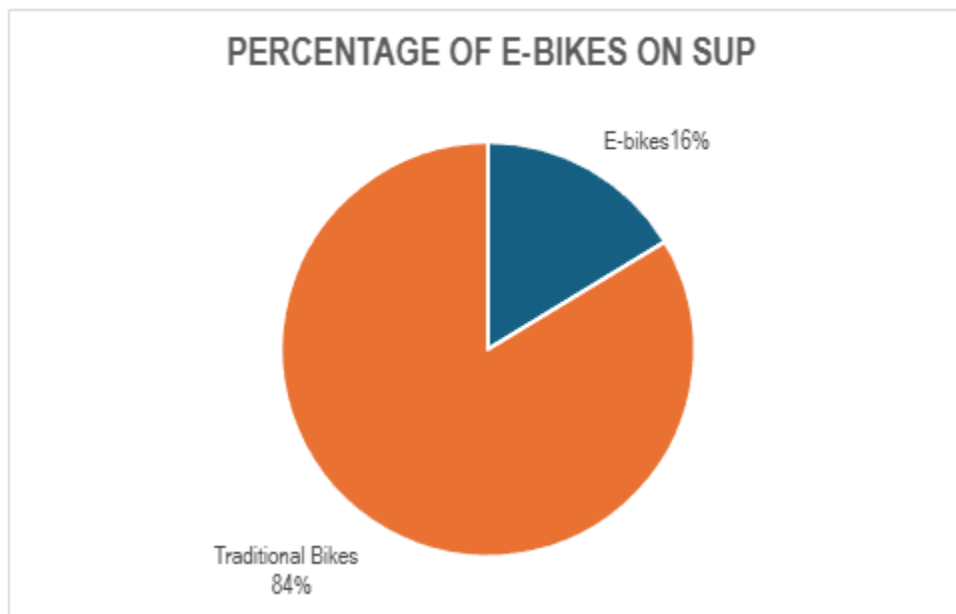

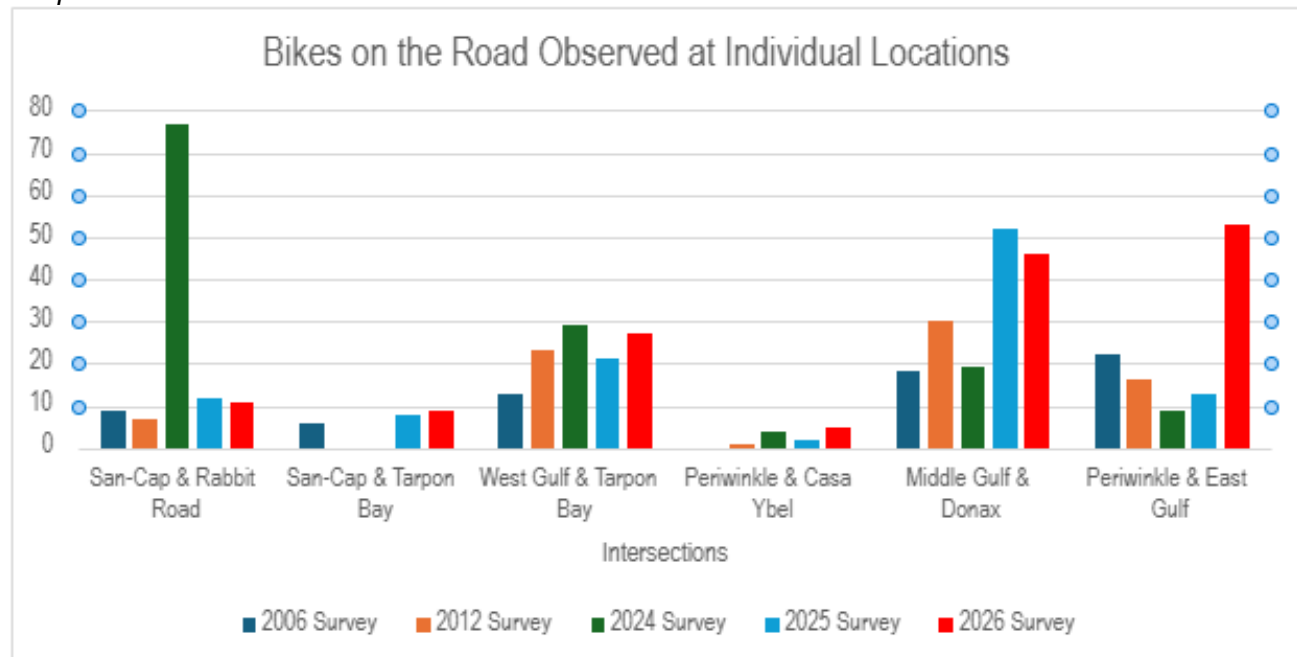

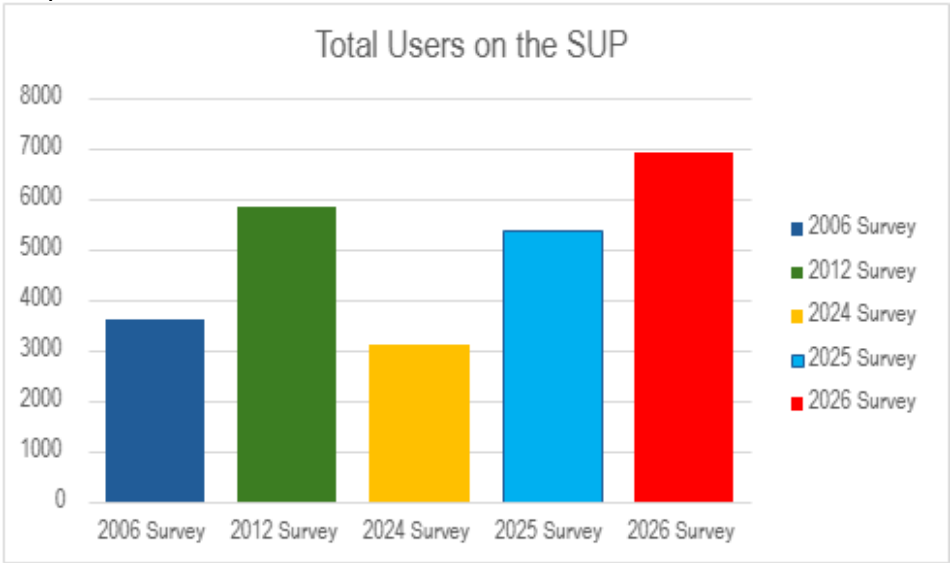

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Summary of Results:

- Total overall users of all types at SUP locations have increased to over 7,000 participants (7091 in 2026). The second closest total was in 2012 with a total of 4506; up 64%.
- Total users on the SUP have increased by 42% since the original study in 2006 and almost doubled since the study from 2025 (3982 to 7091).
- Over one half of the total pedestrian traffic (840 of 1621; 52%) on the SUP was observed at the West Gulf and Tarpon Intersection; this location also had the highest usage of all locations at 1700 users (6 total intersections were considered).
- Electric bicycles represent 16% of total bicycle riders on the SUP, with 868 E-bikes observed. For this study, **ALL** intersection recorded equal distribution of E-bike activity; whereas a large majority (42%) of E-bikes were observed at only two intersections studied at Sanibel Captiva Road in 2025. E-bike class was not recorded.
- Bicycle usage on the road has trended up and is at an all-time high, up by 40% from 2025 and over doubling since 2006 (68 to 151). Worth noting, various locations have led each year the study has been conducted, leading the charge in 2026 was Periwinkle Way and East Gulf Drive.
- The number of bike riders wearing helmets has decreased slightly over the past year (down just 2% from 2025), representing 41% of all bicyclists. In 2006, 37% of bicyclists were using a helmet which remained consistent in the 2012 study, where 38% of bike riders wore helmets.
- Rental Bikes users have increased by 64% since 2006 and over 105% since 2025.
